






Predicting the aesthetic outcome of breast cancer surgery

Treatment of breast cancer usually involves surgery that varies depending on the individual tumour, the size and shape of the breasts or personal wishes. Breast-conserving surgery and mastectomy with or without breast reconstruction or lymph node removal are among the available options. Additionally, radiotherapy can be applied to optimise locoregional control. However, there is currently no way of recapitulating the aesthetic outcome following locoregional treatments for breast cancer. The EU-funded CINDERELLA project proposes to create an easy-to-use application based on AI that uses a clinical database and performs picture and biometric matching to create images that simulate to the patient the outcome of surgery. The platform called CINDERELLA APProach will reinforce the role of the patient in clinical decision-making.















A cataract is a cloudy area in the lens of the eye causing blurry or distorted vision. Cataracts are common in the ageing population and can only be removed with surgery where the cloudy lens is replaced with an artificial one. To predict the outcome of surgery, the KATSIM project, funded by the European Innovation Council, proposes the development of a computational holography approach to simulate vision in patients with cataract. KATSIM will develop the first cataract simulator that will allow clinicians to choose the right replacement lens for each individual patient.

European Partnership on Rare Diseases

The partnership will coordinate national, local and European research and innovation programmes, combining research funding and implementation of research supportive activities such as training, data access infrastructures, data standards etc.

The main goal is to improve the life of patients with rare diseases by developing diagnostics and treatments for rare diseases through multidisciplinary research and innovation programmes with all relevant stakeholders. This will increase impact and uptake of research results as well as increase the visibility of EU leadership in rare diseases research.




MISSION – BUDGET

- 1. There is **no fixed budget** for each mission
- 2. During the **first three years** of the programme, a **maximum of 10%** of the annual budget of **Pillar II** shall be programmed through specific calls for implementing the missions
- 3. For the remaining part of the programme, and **only after a positive assessment** of the mission selection and management process, this **percentage may be increased**


